

Tent Pitching Instructions Baltoro 200



INNER FIRST PITCHING

- 1. Assemble the four poles and lay them parallel on the ground.
- 2. Open inner tent on ground and position in desired direction.
- 3. Insert the longer poles through the mesh pole sleeves running diagonally across the length of the inner. The poles are colour coded to match the corresponding pole sleeve entry point.
- 4. Insert the two remaining poles through pole sleeves running across the width of the inner.
- 5. Locate the ends of the long diagonal poles into the eyelets on one end of groundsheet.
- 6. Push these poles from the opposite side, forming an arch and locate the pole ends into corresponding eyelets on pole anchor strap.
- 7. Repeat this process for the two remaining poles.
- 8. The tent will now be free standing, reposition if required.
- 9. Tighten all pole anchor straps.
- 10. Peg out inner using pin pegs.

FLYSHEET

- 1. Open out flysheet and position over the inner tent. The tent is constructed symmetrically so can be lined up in either direction.
- 2. Attach the hook/loop tabs on the underside of the flysheet around the pole crossover points.
- 3. Attach the clips to the elastic loops at the sides of the tent.
- 4. Connect the side-release buckles at the base of the flysheet to the corresponding socket on the pole anchor straps of the groundsheet.
- 5. Peg out the main anchor straps on both porches and tighten.
- 6. Care should be taken to avoid over tension of the anchor straps as undue stress may cause damage to the flysheet fabric.
- 7. Peg out all guylines ensuring that guyline fabric attachment points are evenly tensioned.
